The Macomb County Bar Association and Sterling Heights Television's coproduction of the law related public education television show *Legally Speaking* recently received three nominations from the Michigan Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.

The *Legally Speaking* episode titled, *The Price of Innocence* tells the dramatic and compelling story of the exonerated - innocent men and women wrongfully imprisoned for decades and then released after DNA evidence proved their innocence. The story is told through several interviews with lawyers, legislators and forensic experts and was broadcast in southeast Michigan on local cable station in late 2005 through the spring of 2006.

Attorney Charlie Langton and Sterling Heights Television producer Matt Phillips each received nominations in the categories of:

- Crime Program and
- Public/Current and Community Affairs Program.

Mr. Phillips also received a nomination in the Editing category.
